1. Vase of Annuals, mixed kinds allowed - *for flowers raised from seed during the 12 months preceeding the show*
2. 5 Stems of Sweet Peas, mixed colours allowed
3. 3 Individual Rose blooms
4. Lilies or Liliums, 3 stems 1 kind
5. 1 Fuchsia, Pot Plant
6. 1 Pelargonium or Geranium (zonal) Pot Plant
7. 3 Spikes of 1 kind e.g Delphinium/Lupin/Gladiolus
8. 3 Panicles of 1 kind e.g Stocks, Flocks, Sweet William
9. 5 Individual blooms, 1 kind, mixed colours allowed e.g  
Pyrethrum/Calendula/Carnation
10. 3 Stems of Flowering Shrub, mixed types allowed

**FRUIT**

11. 1 Dish of 10 Strawberries
12. 1 Dish of 10 Cherries
13. 1 Dish of Currants
14. 3 Sticks of Rhubarb
15. 1 Dish of any other fruit, not mixed varieties

**VEGETABLE**

16. 5 Pods of Broad Beans
17. Cauliflower, 1 head
18. Peas, 5 Pods
19. Mange Tout, 5 pods
20. 5 Potatoes, any variety, white or coloured, mixed not allowed
